

MAC PRINTING SET UP STEPS

1. FIRST, Check Operating system, go to the apple, hit ABOUT THIS MAC and it should say 10. Some number.
2. Find out what driver to use, go to the copier hit counter check then device configuration, then look for UFR II PPD
3. Go to the USA.CANON.COM
4. click OFFICE EQUIPMENT
5. click SUPPORT DRIVERS
6. Under product type, Select copier type either B/W image runner copier, Color image runner copier, or Image pass controller if their copier is equipped with one (on most color C4080/5185 or C3200)
7. Then select product family, select the group in which the copier is located (If its an image pass select C1 3200- H1 4080 or S1)
8. Then select the copier and click driver and software
9. Then Select the operating system
10. Click on Mac drivers and select the driver that corresponds to the information that the copier has
11. download it and open it then run the setup program of the driver, just keep hitting ok or I agree until its finished
12. Once its done go to system preference >> printer and fax >>> hit the + sign in the left corner>>> select IP>>>Protocol Leave LPD>>>type in the IP address>>>In the queue type in PRINT>>>Under Print Using, tell them to click on select driver to use and in search bar type in IR to find the copier faster once selected hit add and print a test page.

If that does not work , you can print generically just by inputting the IP address and using the generic Mac setting, but remember, it has limited functions and only prints from the top drawer.
